RULES AND REGULATIONS

PARTICIPANTS

- Entries will be accepted, BY POSTMARK, beginning on Wednesday, March 16th. In the event that this tournament fills on the first day, preference will be given to teams that fished this event the previous year.
- The first 100 teams entered will be eligible to fish the tournament.
- All teams are subject to a pre-tournament inspection and random on-water inspections.

ORIENTATION

 The orientation meeting will be held at Jimmy Seas at <u>5:45 AM Saturday immediately prior to the</u> <u>start of the tournament</u>. All tournament information should be included in this entry form.

BOATS AND EQUIPMENT

- Safe boating conduct and all safety precautions must be observed at all times.
- ALL CONTESTANTS MUST WEAR LIFE JACKETS WHEN MAIN MOTOR IS USED ABOVE TROLLING SPEED.
- NO alcoholic beverages are permitted in the boat during tournament hours.
- In the event of an electrical storm, contestants are allowed to dock at the nearest shoreline until it is safe to continue fishing.
- All boats are required to meet the U.S. Coast Guard safety requirements.

FISHING WATERS

Fishing will be permitted on the Fox River from the dam at De Pere downriver to the Bay of Green Bay. The waters of Green Bay are open to tournament anglers from the mouth of the Fox River north to a line drawn from the tip of Littletail Point to the tip of Point Comfort. All other waters of Green Bay are off limits.

FISHING HOURS

Fishing hours will be on Saturday, May 14, 2011.
Tournament fishing will start at the end of the
orientation/rules meeting and continue until 3:00
PM. BE ON TIME FOR THE 5:45 AM RULES

BOAT LAUNCHING

 Contestants will launch their boats, after paying any posted launch fees, at any launch facility on the Fox River. Boats will then proceed immediately to the area in front of *Jimmy Seas* and remain there until the rules meeting begins.

FISHING AND SIZE LIMITS

- Only walleye and saugers will be allowed.
- All contestants must comply with all Wisconsin fishing laws. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- No two contestant boats may pull up to each other during tournament hours.
- One contestant must stay with boat at all times during tournament hours. Restrooms are available at the Metro Boat Launch (mouth of the river), Fox Point Landing, Fairgrounds Landing, and at Voyageur Park. These facilities may be used during tournament hours.
- CB, marine radios, and cell phone are to be used for emergencies ONLY. Tournament directors can be reached at 920-660-4134 or 920-242-1746.
- All fish must be held in an <u>AERATED LIVEWELL</u>.
 This is a catch and release tournament.
- NO binoculars are allowed in the boats.
- THE DAILY LIMIT IS 5 (five) WALLEYE OR SAUGER PER TEAM. THERE IS A 15-INCH SIZE LIMIT PER FISH.

WEIGH-IN

- Weigh-in will start at 3:00 pm Saturday. <u>There will</u> be no early weigh-in available.
- Boats will be called to the dock to weigh their fish by their boat number.
- Anglers will drop off one partner with fish on the dock and then proceed back into the river to clear the dock area. After weighing fish the angler will be picked up at a designated dock and the boat will proceed to the landing to be trailered. Anglers can then return to *Jimmy Seas* with their tow vehicle and view the weigh-in.
